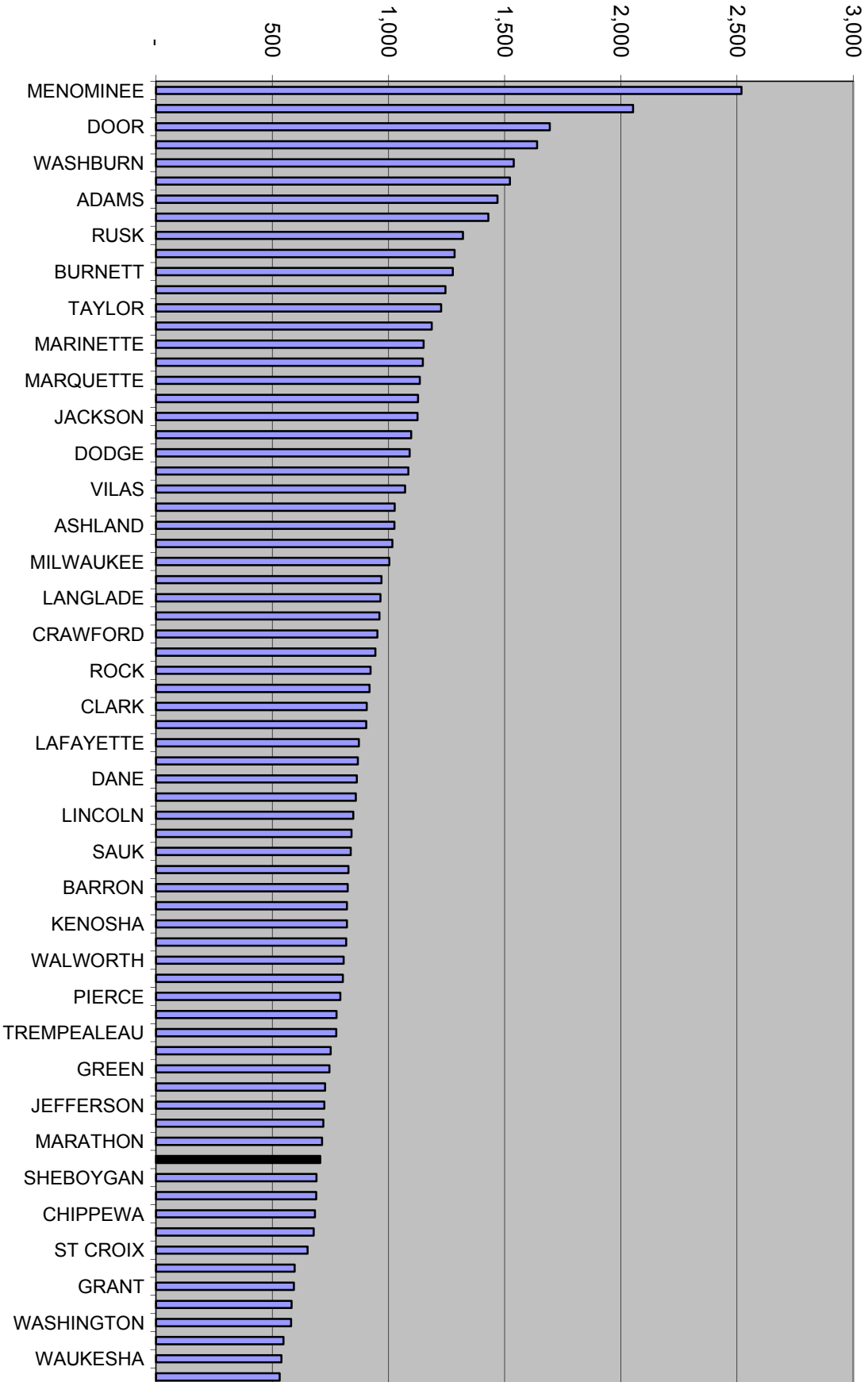

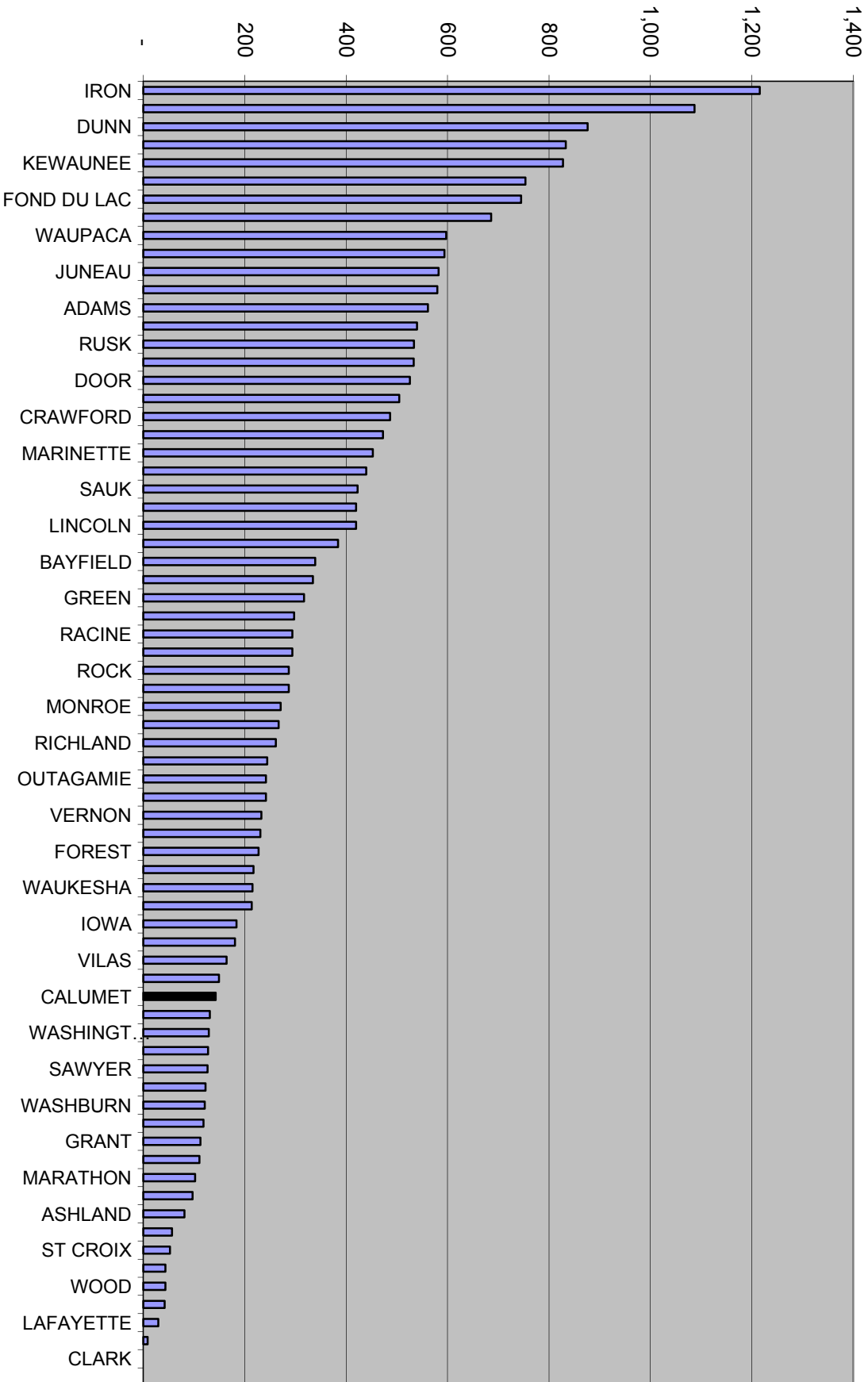

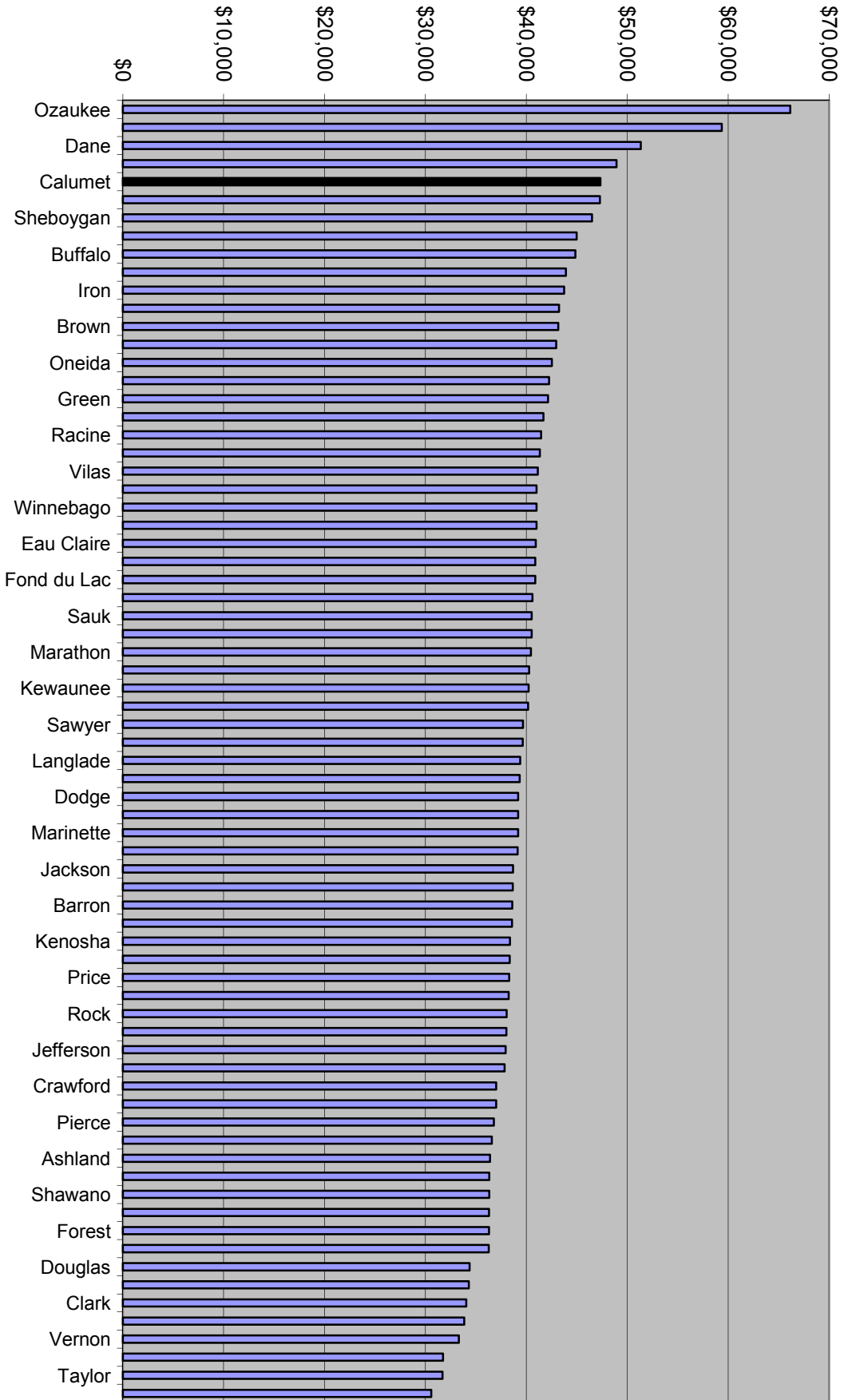
2013 County Operating & Capital Spending Per Person



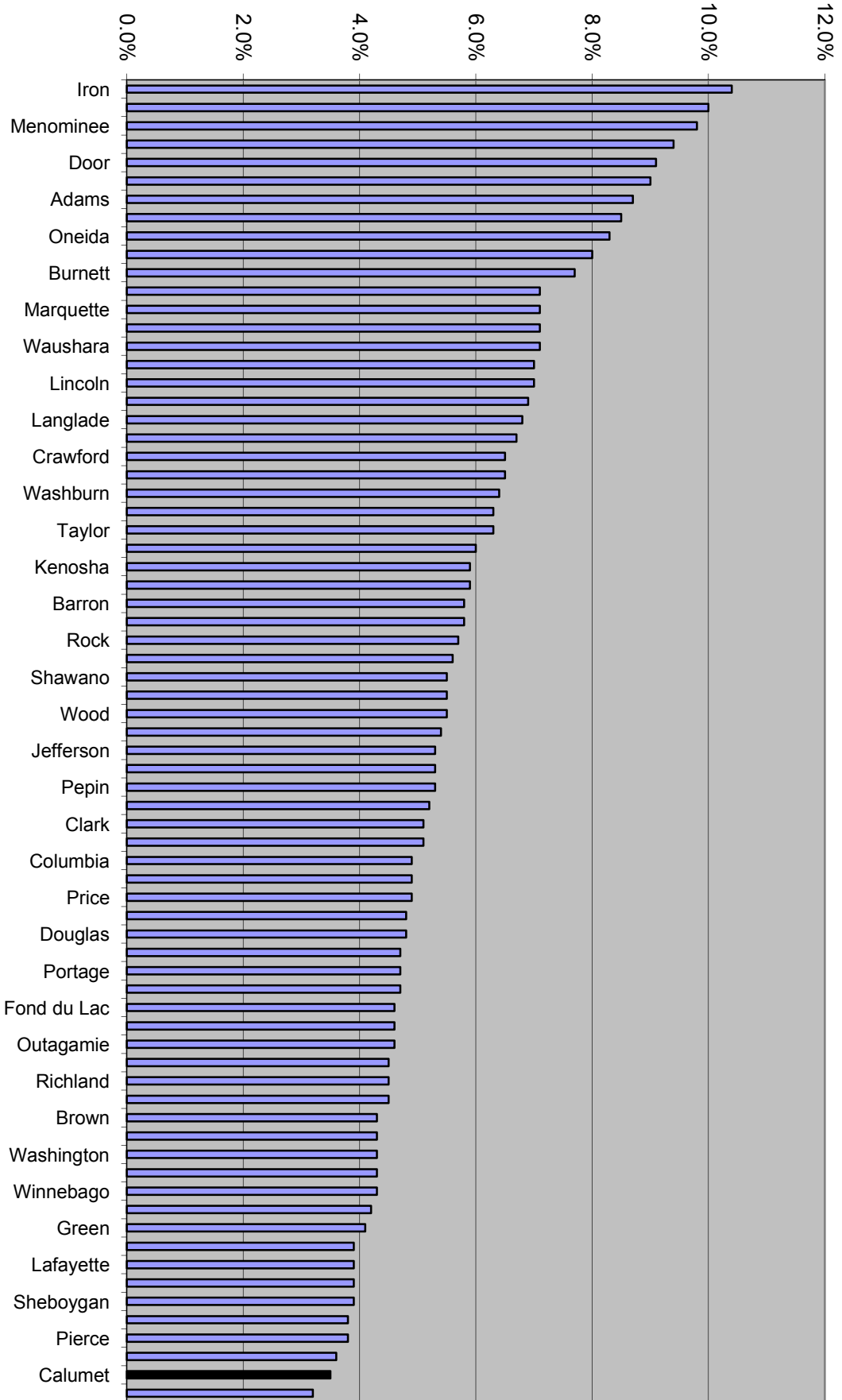
2013 County Outstanding Debt Per Person



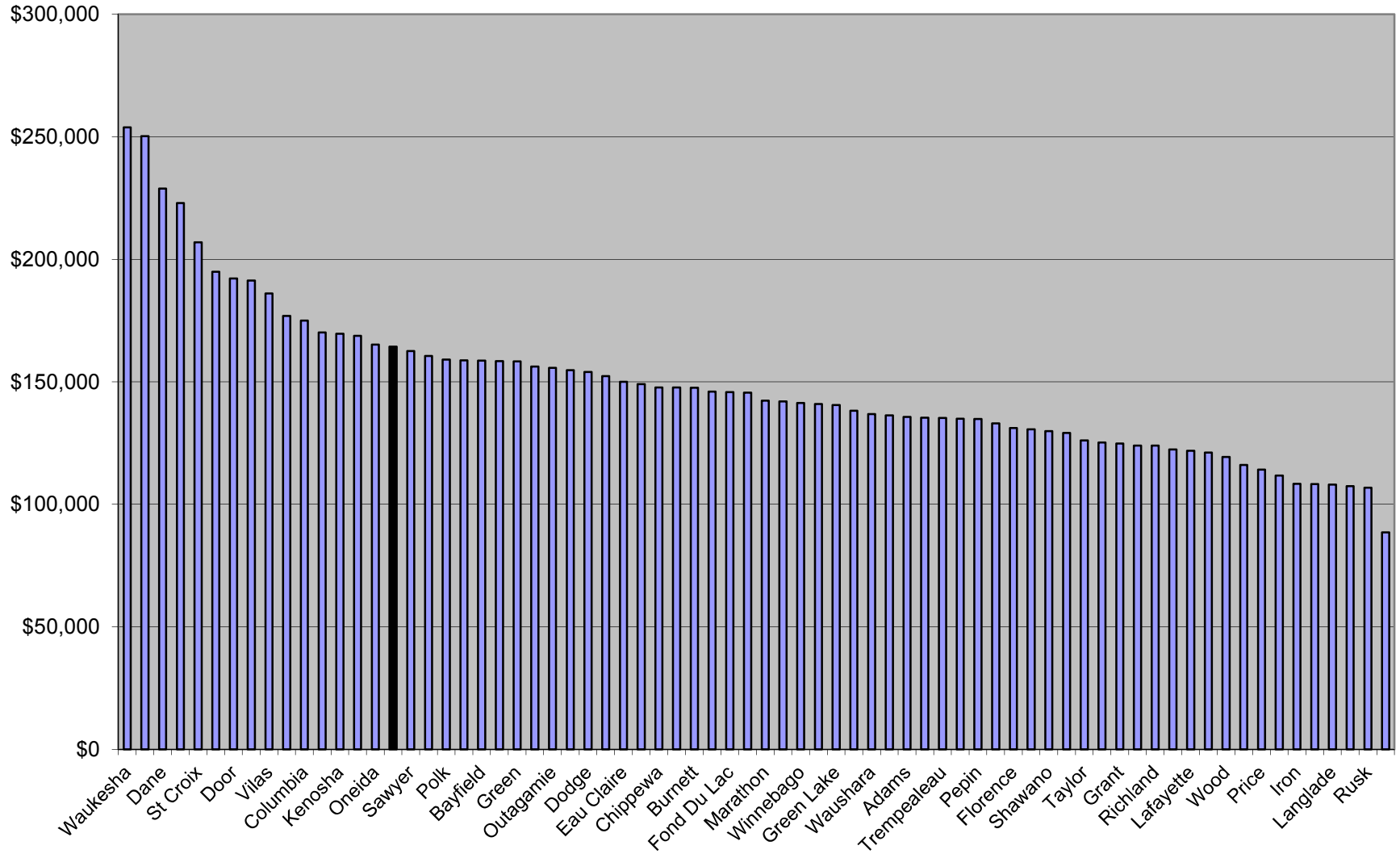
2013 County Personal Income Per Person



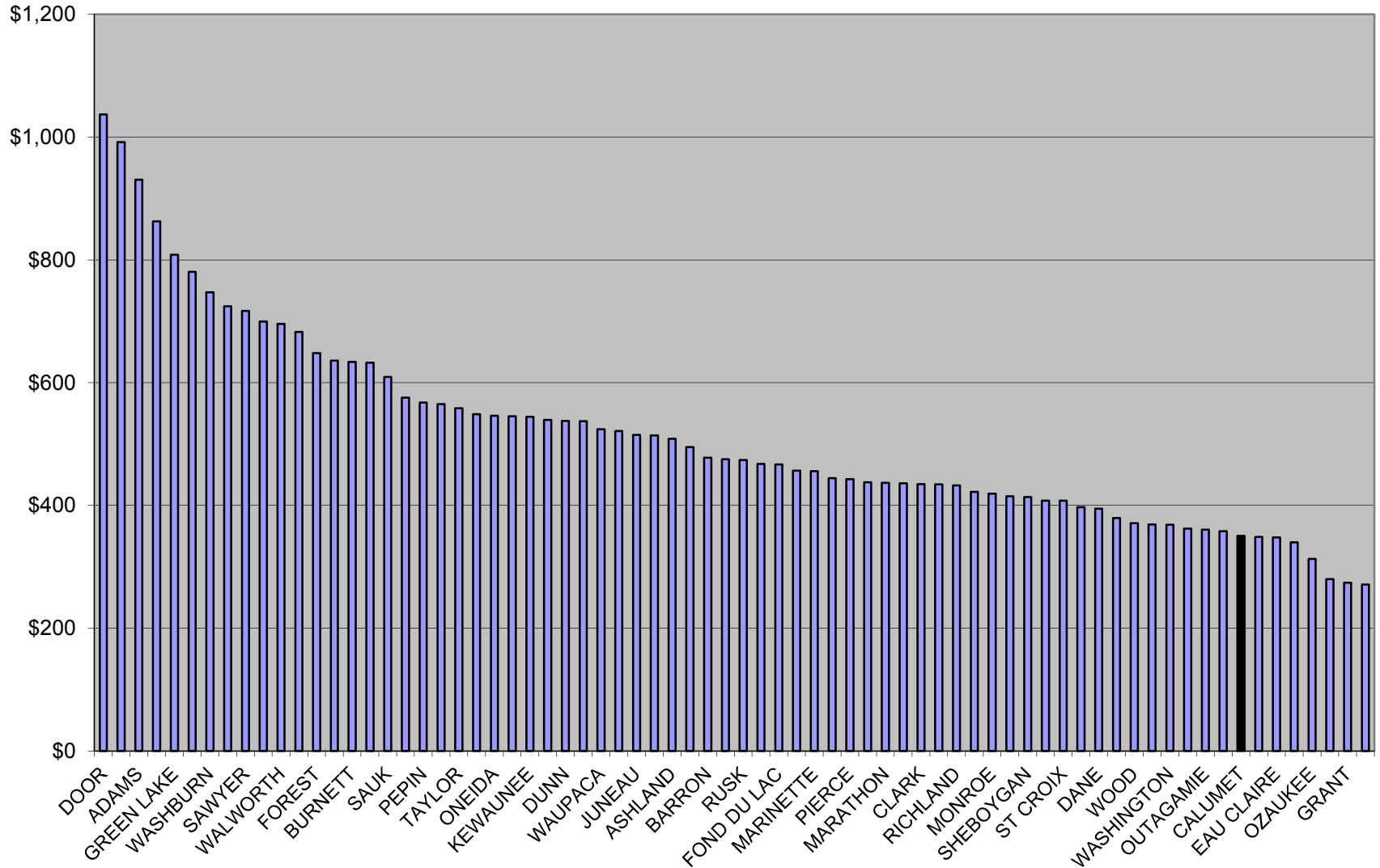
January 2015 County Unemployment



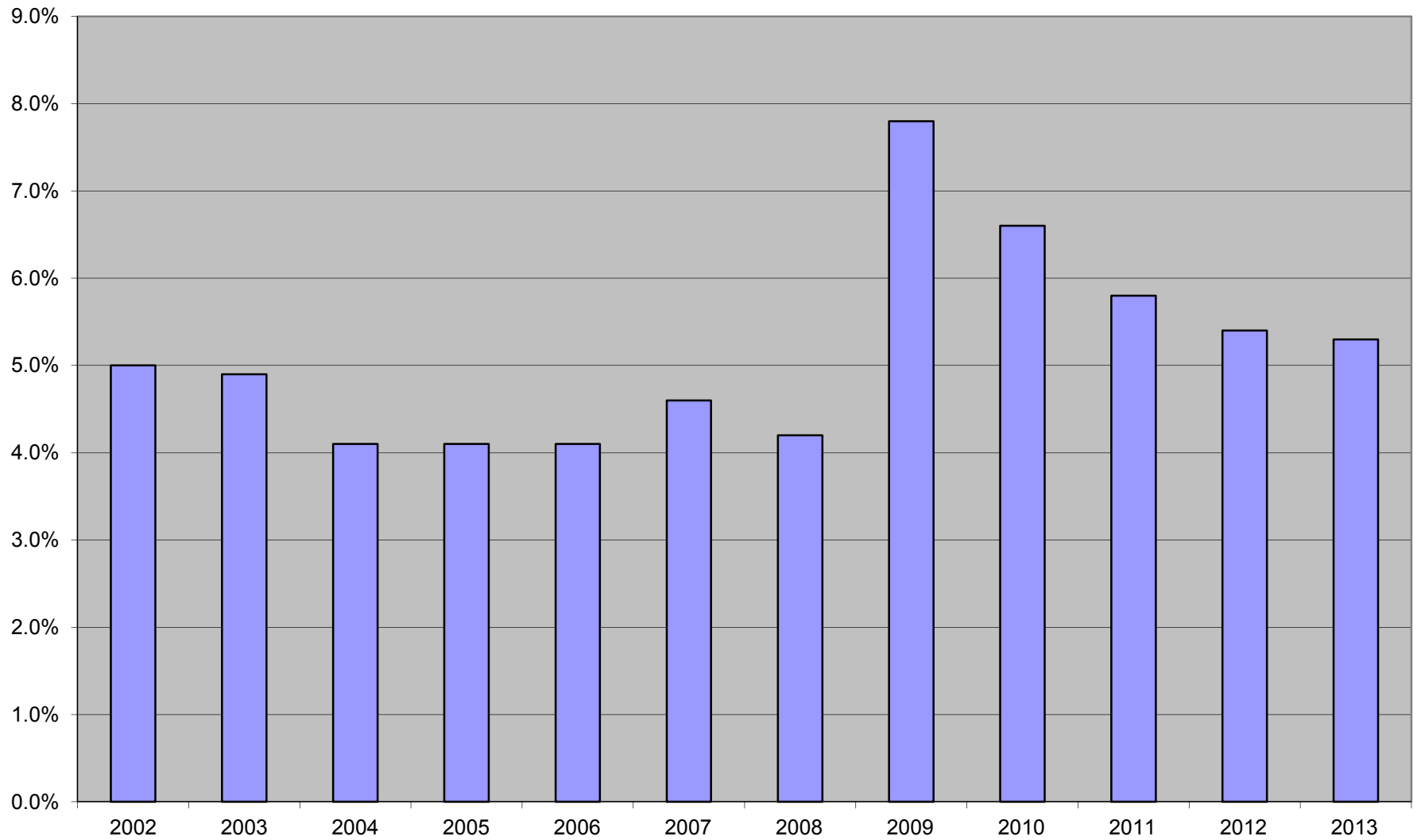
2013 County Median Home Value
