B. DPI UPDATE.

Dr. Bar-Lev shared with the board a brief video in which Jill Underly (Wisconsin State Superintendent of Public Instruction) welcomed the attendees to the Virtual Leadership Conference.

Dr. Bar-Lev distributed an Eligibility Chart for students who are blind and deaf, along with a checklist and PI 11 Administrative Codes. Discussion was held on the Schools for the Visually Impaired and Deaf Hearing Impaired.

C. Proposed 2022/23 CDEB Budget.

Dr. Bar-Lev presented the 2022-2023 CDEB Proposed Budget and responded to questions on various budget items.

A motion by Judith Hartl to approve the 2022-2023 CDEB proposed budget was made and approved by Ken Irwin and seconded by Mary Schwalenberg. Motion passed unanimously. Dr. Bar-Lev will present the budget at the County Board of Supervisors Board Meeting on May 17, 2022.
