

**PLEASE CHECK THE APPROPRIATE FILING:**

**DOMESTIC ABUSE – NO FILING FEE/SERVICE FEE REQUIRED** (NOTE: Effective April 10, 2014, the 2013 Wisconsin Act 321 now provides that persons subject to Domestic Abuse and Child Abuse injunctions require mandatory firearm surrender)

Domestic Abuse is defined in Wis. Stat. Sec. 813.12(1) means:

- any of the following engaged in by an adult family member against another adult family member;
- by an adult against his/her adult former spouse; by an adult against an adult with whom the individual has or had a dating relationship; or
- by an adult against and adult with whom the person has a child in common:

an intentional infliction of or threat to inflict physical pain, physical injury or illness; impairment of physical condition; or sexual contact or sexual intercourse without consent (under sec 940.225). There must be facts showing imminent danger of physical harm before a temporary restraining order can be issued.

**HARASSMENT (Check Appropriate Type)** (The Court may order firearm surrender for Harassment injunctions.)

\_\_\_\_\_ Harassment as defined in Wis. Stat. Sec. 813.125(1)(a) means any of the following:

- Striking, shoving, kicking, intentional infliction of personal injury or otherwise subjecting another person to physical contact, engaging in an act that would constitute abuse, sexual assault under s. 940.225, or stalking under s. 940.32; or attempting or threatening to do the same **(NO FILING/SERVICE FEES)**

\_\_\_\_\_ Harassment is defined in Wis. Stat. Sec. 813.125(1)(b) as:

- Engaging in a course of conduct or repeatedly committing acts which harass or intimidate another person and which serve no legitimate purpose\*\* **(\$164.50 FILING FEE/PLUS SERVICE FEES)**

\*\*if your petition is *without* allegations as set forth under 813.125(1)(a) above , 814.61(1)

**INJUNCTIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS AT RISK – NO FILING OR SERVICE FEE REQUIRED**

(The Court may order firearm surrender for Individuals at Risk injunctions.)

The individual at risk as defined in Wis. Stat. Sec. 813.123 is:

- an adult at risk (an adult who has a physical or mental condition that substantially impairs his/her ability to care for his/her needs and who has experienced, is currently experiencing, or is at risk of experiencing physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual abuse, treatment without consent, unreasonable confinement or restraint, neglect, self-neglect, or financial exploitation)
- an elder adult at risk (a person age 60 or older who has experienced, is currently experiencing, or is at risk of experiencing physical abuse, emotional abuse, sexual abuse, treatment without consent, unreasonable confinement or restraint, neglect, self-neglect, or financial exploitation)

**CHILD ABUSE – NO FILING OR SERVICE FEE REQUIRED – Wis. Stat. Sec. 813.122(1)**

**\*If Temporary Restraining Order is denied, I wish to pursue a Hearing upon payment of filing fee if applicable.\***
