How should I dispose of alkaline batteries?

Alkaline batteries have been deemed as non-hazardous since the 1990s when congress started limiting the use of Mercury in batteries. Since alkaline batteries are classified as non-hazardous, you can safely dispose of them in your regular trash can.



Although alkaline batteries are non-hazardous, they are made of important metals that can be recycled.

There are very few local places where alkaline batteries can be dropped off for recycling so mail in options are often more convenient and accessible.
