Your Guide for Safe Disposal and Recycling in Calumet County

How do I dispose of old appliance?

Appliances including: air conditioners, boilers, washers and dryers, dehumidifiers, dishwashers, freezers, furnaces, microwaves, ovens, refrigerators, stoves, and water heaters have all been banned from Wisconsin landfills since 1991.

Many appliances contain hazardous and toxic materials that need to be disposed of properly. Refrigerators and air conditioners contain chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs) which can destroy the ozone layer of our atmosphere. Other hazardous materials found in appliances include: used oil, PCBs, and mercury.

The easiest way to dispose of old appliances is to get them hauled away when your new ones arrive. You can make these arrangements with the seller. If this option is not available then you can call your local waste disposal company.
