Community Support Program (CSP)

What is the Community Support Program (CSP)?

Calumet County's Community Support Program (CSP) is certified by the *Wisconsin Department of Health Services* to provide comprehensive mental health treatment and case management services to adults diagnosed with severe and persistent mental illness (e.g. Schizophrenia, Bipolar Disorder).

The objective of the Community Support Program (CSP) is to reduce the frequency and duration of psychiatric hospitalizations and/or other institutional settings, by providing coordinated care and treatment in a community setting. The program focuses on identifying and using the individual's strengths to promote recovery and self-sufficiency, resulting in an improved quality of life.



What type of treatment is provided in the Community Support Program (CSP)?

Treatment is individualized, based on needs and goals identified during a comprehensive assessment. Services may include:

- Psychiatric services
- Psychotherapy
- Social/recreational skills training
- Life skills training
- Social opportunities via our monthly CSP drop in groups
- Medication management and monitoring
- Case management and connection to resources
- Vocational rehabilitation
