- Senior Division (Grades 10-12)

- Conservation Message (50%)
- Visual Effectiveness (30%)
- Originality (10%)
- Universal Appeal (10%)

What Makes a Good Poster?

Clear Message

Include a simple, engaging message or theme that is easy for the audience to understand and relate to.

Creativity & Originality

Encourage imaginative designs and unique ideas that reflect your personal interpretations of the theme, showcasing your creativity.

Bold Visuals

Use bright colors and eye-catching designs to grab attention and make the poster visually appealing.

Don't forget the THEME!

Your poster should clearly display the words of the Theme! "Soil: Where it all Begins"
