This letter is to continue outreach for the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) maintenance improvement project along WIS 441 from I-41 to South Oneida Street (see attached map).

Since the 6-lane expansion of WIS 441 from I-41 to South Oneida Street, there has been settlement on the approaches to the structures along the corridor. This project will improve the riding surface by replacing the concrete approaches to 13 bridges including:

- B-70-401 – westbound US 10/WIS 441 over I-41;
- B-70-402 – northbound I-41 to eastbound WIS 441 ramp over railroad;
- B-70-403 – eastbound WIS 441 over Little Lake Butte des Morts;
- B-70-410/411 – WIS 441 over Tayco Street;
- B-70-420/421 – WIS 441 over County P/Racine Road;
- B-70-423/424 – WIS 441 over County AP/Midway Road;
- B-70-113/114 – WIS 441 over WIS 47/Appleton Road;
- B-70-115/116 – WIS 441 over US 10/Oneida Street.

Proposed work includes new concrete structure approaches, replacement of beam guard and barrier wall within these approach areas, storm sewer adjustments, pavement markings and traffic control. Construction is expected to extend from late April 2025 (following the NFL draft) through Fall 2025. There will be significant traffic impacts along the WIS 441 corridor during our improvement project.

Impacts to WIS 441 mainline traffic include:

- Both directions of WIS 441 from I-41 to South Oneida Street will be reduced full time from three lanes to two lanes throughout the project
- Westbound US 10/WIS 441 over I-41 bridge will be closed for roughly 4 nights. Detour route will follow northbound I-41 to County BB to southbound I-41 to westbound US 10
- Impacts to oversized/overweight (OSOW) routes within the 10/41/441 interchange due to restricted widths
- Speed reduction from 65 mph to 55 mph

Impacts to interchange ramps along the corridor include:

- **Exit ramp from eastbound WIS 441 to County P/Racine Road** will be closed for roughly 2 months. Detour route will follow eastbound WIS 441 to County AP/Midway Road to County P/Racine Road.
- **Entrance ramp to westbound WIS 441 from County P/Racine Road** will be closed for roughly 2 months. Detour route will follow eastbound WIS 441 to County AP/Midway Road to westbound WIS 441.
- **Entrance ramp (loop) to eastbound WIS 441 from southbound I-41** will be closed for roughly 2 months. Detour route will follow southbound I-41 to westbound US 10 to County CB to eastbound US 10/WIS 441.
- **Entrance ramp to eastbound WIS 441 from northbound I-41** will be closed for roughly 4 nights.
- **Entrance ramp to westbound US 10 from northbound I-41** will be closed for roughly 2 nights.

In an effort to minimize inconvenience for the traveling public, the contract duration has been significantly compressed, and this work is also being staged to minimize overlap with multiple other area projects.

Details for our WIS 441 maintenance improvement are included on the larger website for the I-41 (Appleton – De Pere) expansion project at <https://i41project.wisconsin.gov/adjacent-projects>. During construction, we will have a WIS 441 Construction webpage on our 511 Wisconsin Travel Information website at www.511wi.gov. A virtual local officials meeting will be held prior to the start of construction. Changeable message signs will be used as needed to advise the public of changing conditions. We will also be communicating any updates via our Northeast Region Twitter account, the I-41 Expansion Project Twitter and Facebook accounts.
