Prevention Services

Immunizations

Immunizations are available by appointment. Call Public Health at (920) 849-1400 to schedule an appointment.

Immunizations may be required for students entering 5K, Grade 7, and Grade 12.

Calumet County Public Health offers vaccines at no charge to children up to age 19 who:

- have no health insurance, or
- are covered by Medicaid (BadgerCare Plus, etc.), or
- have health insurance that does not cover the needed vaccines, or
- are American Indian or Alaska Native.

Uninsured and underinsured adults may also be eligible to receive certain state-supplied vaccines free of charge. For more information, contact Calumet County Public Health.



Car Seat Safety Education

Free car seat safety checks are available for all families by appointment. Call Public Health at (920) 849-1400 to schedule an appointment.



Lead Poison Prevention Services

Free blood lead testing is available for children 6 months to 6 years of age who either have no health insurance or are underinsured.

Calumet County Public Health follows blood lead testing guidelines from the Wisconsin Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Program.

Harm Reduction

To lessen adverse health outcomes and protect individuals, Calumet County Public Health distributes:

- Narcan (naloxone)
- Fentanyl test strips

Training is offered to everyone requesting Narcan and fentanyl test strips.

Maternal Child Health Services

Services for pregnant people, parents, children and their families, including information, resources, and referrals.

Parenting Education

Offered to parents on an individual basis

Communicable Disease Prevention

Individual / Group Health Education

Education and/or presentations on a broad range of health-related topics

WIC (Women, Infants, Children)

Food supplement program for pregnant people, infants, and children through age 5. Health and financial needs determine eligibility. Call the WIC office at (920) 849-1420 for more information.
